

ASSE DANMARK STUDENT PROGRAM RULES

1. The following Rules for Asse Danmark Students (“Rules”) have been established by ASSE Danmark as minimum standards of participant conduct, and any infraction may result in immediate repatriation (return) of the Student to his/her home country:
2. It has been arranged for you to attend school and attendance is mandatory. You must take classes in your host country’s history, government and language, in addition to other required or challenging classes. You may not receive failing marks/grades or a complaint from your school. Your classroom behavior and academic performance must be exemplary. Your host school makes the final decision about your grade level placement, as well as if receipt of a diploma, academic credits, and/or graduation is possible for you. You must abide by your host school’s decision. Participation in extracurricular school activities (e.g. sports, drama, band, etc.) is not guaranteed and may not be available at the school in which you are enrolled.
3. All use, purchase or possession of alcohol, drugs, tobacco, e-cigarettes, vaporizers or harmful controlled substances is prohibited.
4. Tattooing or body piercing are strictly prohibited during your stay.
5. You are not allowed to drive or purchase a motorized vehicle. Participation in driver’s education programs and/or obtaining a driver’s license may not be possible in the area or school in which you are placed. In addition, student insurance does not permit you to drive or ride the following vehicles: motorcycles, mopeds, scooters, ATV’s, any two or three wheeled motorized vehicle, snowmobiles, and/or sport watercraft such as wave runners, jet skis or other such powered devices. Accidents and injuries as a result of these activities will not be covered by the student insurance, whether you are driving or riding as a passenger.
6. It is required that you spend the Christmas/New Year holidays and other major holidays and family celebrations with your Host Family. You are only allowed to travel outside your local area if travel is done with your host family or with a ASSE Danmark approved church/school group. And if so, you must have permission from ASSE Danmark, your host family and natural parents.
7. For the benefit of the program ASSE Danmark strongly encourages you to limit texting, phone calls and real time communication with friends and natural family in your home country to allow you to immerse yourself in your exchange program.
8. You are not allowed to take a job during your stay.
9. All your activities must be approved by your host parents. You must always advise your host parents of your whereabouts and when you will return home.
10. You must abide by the decisions of ASSE Danmark, its representatives and your Host Family.
11. You must not borrow money from or lend money to your host family or other persons in your host community.
12. As visits by natural parents can seriously jeopardize a participant’s success in the program, ASSE Danmark does not permit parents or guardians to visit their son or daughter for the duration of the program. Visits after the last day of school are permitted, provided the ASSE Danmark and the Coordinator, is advised of the plans well in advance. No visits by friends or siblings are allowed at any time during the program.
13. With the exception of volunteer returns or repatriations, ASSE Danmark will not permit you to return home until the Program’s conclusion.
14. You consent to the use of your name, photograph, film or video likeness or any comments or statements made in your application, in materials or publications utilized to promote our Program.

Each Student and his or her Parent(s) or Guardian(s) must acknowledge that they understand and have agreed to adhere to the above Rules prior to the Student’s final program acceptance.
