The country is relatively flat with lakes, farmlands, woodlands, traffic-free biking and walking streets, and no part of the country is more than an hour from the sea. In fact, some of the activities your host family may include you in, are sailing, fishing, canoeing, and kayaking. The Danes love to use their country, during summer and even winter, you will see the social life present in the streets, during cultural activities and outside on street cafes.
