THE SCHOOL

In all cases you will go to school five days a week, except in some schools where they have one half day. Lessons start around 9 o'clock in the morning and finish by 4 pm, depending on the school. The school year starts at the beginning of September. Fall term is from September until December and spring semester from January until June.
